
Alternate Eyelet and Clip (6000-43) Replacement Procedure

In the absence of a flaring punch the following procedure can be used to install a replacement eyelet and clip.


Recommended Tools


- 1. Pliers, Needle Nose
- 2. Phillips bit or driver.
- 3. Hammer



Step 1: Punching the Eyelet. Use a Phillips bit and hammer to punch the non-flared end of the eyelet. This splits it into sections that make it easy to crimp with pliers.

Step 2: Flaring the Eyelet. Use Needle nose pliers to push the sections apart.





Step 3: Crimping the Eyelet. Use needle nose pliers to flatten and crimp the eyelet around the clip.
